



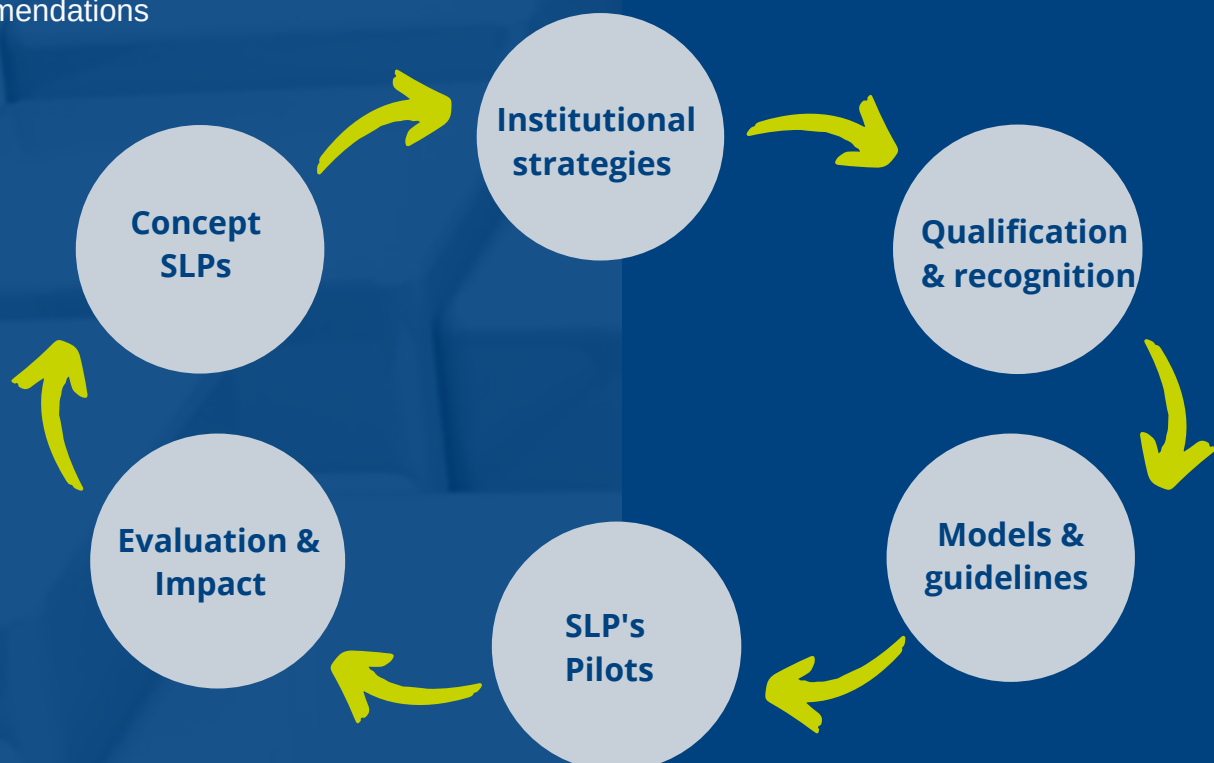
European Short Learning Programmes

E-SLP is a project about Short Learning Programmes (SLPs) on an European level for continuous professional development and lifelong learning.

SLPs consist of courses with a common subject focussing on specific needs in society and which can be part of larger degrees.

THE OBJECTIVES OF THE E-SLP PROJECT ARE:

- **Defining** SLPs role within higher education
- **Promoting** SLPs as a way to achieve economic and personal development goals
- **Empowering** universities to develop high quality SLPs that are flexible and scalable
- **Developing** guidelines for creating collaborative SLPs, including mobility
- **Harmonizing** the qualifications of SLPs for recognition within the European Qualification Framework
- **Supporting** the mainstreaming of SLPs through institutional, governmental and EU level recommendations
